Guide to the Bit the Spectrum online courses



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
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This document outlines how to take the online course “**Augmented and Virtual Reality Features for Professionals in Special Education Needs**”, developed under the Bit the Spectrum project and achieve your certificate of completion.

How to sign up at academia skills

First, go to <https://academiaskills.eu/>.

Click on “join us”. In the “register” form, enter your email address and create a username and a password. Upon registering, you will be redirected to your profile main page.



In this page you can keep track of your progress in the courses enrolled and manage your certificates. If you click on Settings → General, you can edit your profile and enter your full name, profile picture, bio information and change your password.

Note that the name you enter is the one that will appear on your certificate. If you do not add your full name, username will appear.

How to enroll in courses

Once logged in, go back to Academia Skills home page and click on “view courses”. You will be redirected to the catalogue. Click on the desired course to get an overview of the content. Click on “start now” to enroll.


